
DRILL BITS:

HITCH REQUIRES 1/2" PIN AND CLIP.

WRENCHES: (TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS WITH TORQUE WRENCH) 13mm, 3/4



- 1. REMOVE LOWER, INBOARD M8 BUMPER BOLT ON DRIVER'S SIDE AND RETURN TO VEHICLE OWNER.
- 2. ENLARGE DIAMOND SHAPED HOLE IN BOTH FRAME RAILS TO ACCEPT BLOCKS AND CARRIAGE BOLTS.

  3. FISHWIRE CARRIAGE BOLTS AND BLOCKS THROUGH ENLARGED ACCESS HOLE INTO EXISTING HOLES.
- 3. FISHWIRE CARRIAGE BOLTS AND BLOCKS THROUGH ENLARGED ACCESS HOLE INTO EXISTING HOLES IN FRAME AS SHOWN.
- 4. RAISE HITCH INTO POSITION AND INSTALL 1/2" LOCKWASHERS, NUTS AND M8 FASTENER AS SHOWN.
- 5. FISHWIRE CARRIAGE BOLT AND BLOCK THROUGH ENLARGED ACCESS HOLE AS SHOWN. INSTALL 1/2" LOCKWASHER AND NUT.

TIGHTEN M8 CL9.8 FASTENERS TO 25 LB-FT TIGHTEN 1/2" GR5 FASTENERS TO 75 LB-FT
